What is different about a Learning Toolbox ePoster?

You can add more than just one file or resource.

Learning Toolbox allows you to create a *collection* of materials (a *stack*) to present to and share your work.

Key steps

Consider what content (presentations, videos, weblinks, documents) you have which presents and explains your work well. Gather that content together ready to include in your ePoster/stack.









Click on your invite link and create your account

Sign-in to my.ltb.io and create your ePoster stack

Preview and check your ePoster then mark it as ready

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We will publish your ePoster & **print** your summary poster so that delegates can access it
