



Open and explore an ePoster

3. Click on the **X button** to close the viewer and return to the Showcase




Post comments or questions on an ePoster

Favourite (and return to) an ePoster




Favourite/Follow

Install the [Learning Toolbox App](#) on your phone and sign-in to get **notifications** of chat activity on an ePoster you have favourited (or where you are the editing author)



Sharing an ePoster



1. Click on the **more menu**
2. Choose **Stack Info**
3. Here you can see (and download/copy) the ePoster's **QR code** and **web address**

Tweet, email, show or share the code or web address to direct others to your ePoster

1. Click on the **QR icon** on the ePoster's summary box in the showcase
2. The pop-up window will show you the **QR code**
3. And the **web address** for that ePoster

Welcome to Learning Toolbox

Learning Toolbox (LTB) is a software platform that allows people to quickly and easily build their own stacks of interactive and multimedia material and share them with others. LTB is being used in two main contexts:

Events and Conferences



as an ePoster platform and also as a way for speakers and attendees to easily share their work and build connections.

Education and Training



as a tool to support work-based learning (project and portfolio work) and as a way of easily sharing learning resources with others.




