

Viewers of your ePoster can view and engage with this text chat and get notifications of new messages.


Easy for viewers to return to your ePoster




From the ePoster Showcase and from the mini-poster wall, delegates (and authors) can:

Sharing an ePoster





1. Click on the **more menu**

From here you can see the ePoster's unique **QR code** and **web address** and share to **Twitter**


Tweeting during the conference

We are committed to developing innovative & effective technology enhanced learning tools to support our students. The myPAL (my Personalised Adaptive Learning) project is working with students & tutors to co-design different views (visualisations) onto their learning data, which will help them to reflect on & manage their learning.

Example ePosters co-design self-regulation teaching-and-learning technology


Take home message
Students want to have visualisations of their learning data that show progression and support their own management of their learning. Co-design (giving students the tools and support to design learning data visualisations) can help us to understand and better support their learning needs when developing Technology Enhanced Learning systems.

ePosters at AMEE & Ottawa


ePosters have been accepted for Ottawa 2022 and AMEE 2022 as either:

- For on-demand access – ‘ePoster On Demand’
- For a live presentation online (remote presentation)
- For a live presentation onsite


AMEE will have told you in which category your ePoster has been accepted.

Preparing for your Live ePoster Presentation

- **Practise** Open your ePoster in the preview
 - Make sure you know which content you are going to use for your presentation
 - Be sure that you can give your presentation in 3 minutes (AMEE presentations) or *5 minutes (Ottawa)*




Remote ePoster Presentations

- The ePoster presentations will take place in a standard Zoom meeting room.
- The Zoom link has been sent to you and will also be available from the online programme.
- The Chair will introduce each presenter.
- You should have your ePoster open and ready. When the Chair introduces you, you can share your screen and use any of the content in your ePoster for your presentation.
- There will be a short time for Q&A after your presentation.
- A Kubify team member will be in the room.



Remote ePoster Timings

- Join the Zoom meeting **15 minutes before the start** of the session.
- Your presentation should be no more than **3 minutes for AMEE presentations** (*5 minutes for Ottawa*)
- There will be **2 minutes for Q&A** after your AMEE presentation (*3 minutes for Ottawa presentations*)

- **Practise**
- **Relax and just give the key points of your work**
- **Explore the ePosters of your fellow presenters**

Live onsite ePoster presentation sessions



Onsite ePoster Presentations

- The ePoster presentations will take place in a standard presentation room (*the location will be in the programme*).
- The computer in the room will be showing the ePoster showcase (*filtered to show your session*).
- The Chair will introduce each presenter.
- You will be able to open your ePoster and use any of the its content during your presentation.
- There will be a short time for Q&A after your presentation.
- A Kubify team member will be in the room.



Onsite ePoster Presentations - Timings


- Come to the presentation room **15 minutes before the start** of the session.
- Your presentation should be no more than **3 minutes for AMEE presentations** (*5 minutes for Ottawa*)
- There will be **2 minutes for Q&A** after your AMEE presentation (*3 minutes for Ottawa presentations*)



Preparing for your ePoster Presentation


- **Practise** Open your ePoster in the preview and make sure you can give your presentation using the content in your ePoster in 3 minutes for AMEE presentations (5 minutes for Ottawa)
- **Keep it simple and short**
- **Explore your fellow presenter's ePosters**


