To provide an easy (and updateable) way for each workstream to promote, explain and share their work online


- Each workstream will create an ePoster presenting their work

- The ePosters are updateable even after being published
- Each ePoster can also be used outside the WWQA website

Learning Toolbox allows you to create a *collection* of materials (a *stack*) to present to and share your work.








Viewers can click on your ePoster's title to open your ePoster and explore the content you have added.

Your ePoster has its own chat channel.




Viewers of your ePoster will be able to view and engage with this text chat and get email notifications of new messages.

We are committed to developing innovative & effective technology enhanced learning tools to support our students. The myPAL (my Personalised Adaptive Learning) project is working with students & tutors to co-design different views (visualisations) onto their learning data, which will help them to reflect on & manage their learning.



Example ePosters co-design self-regulation teaching-and-learning technology

Take home message

Students want to have visualisations of their learning data that show progression and support their own management of their learning. Co-design (giving students the tools and support to design learning data visualisations) can help us to understand and better support their learning needs when developing Technology Enhanced Learning systems.



You can print a mini-poster for your ePoster.

You can then display this mini-poster in a location where you want to draw attention to your work.

Updateable


- The ePosters are not locked even when they are published.

Key steps to using Learning Toolbox

Consider what content (presentations, videos, weblinks, documents) you have which presents and explains your work well. Gather that content together ready to include in your ePoster stack.

Sign-in to <u>my.ltb.io</u> and create your ePoster/stack Your ePosters will be published to the WWQA website
